

Accreditation Procedure of Rabin Medical Center (foreign clinical practise site)

Decision of the Board of the Hungarian Accreditation Committee (MAB) No. 2024/5/XIII/5

The MAB Board supports the accreditation of Rabin Medical Center (Petah Tikva, Israel) as a clinical practice site for 5 years until September 27, 2029. The accreditation covers the following specialities: internal medicine, surgery, neurology, gynecology. The clinical practise site does not accept students in the psychiatry and pediatrics specialities, so the accreditation does not cover these areas.

Justification:

The key criteria of the simplified procedure were fulfilled by the clinical practice site as follows.

The clinical practice site undertook to train students and indicated the number of students to be admitted (15 students per speciality). The clinical practice site has made a statement that the profile and capacity of the hospital had not changed compared to the previous accreditation. Excellent feedback was received from students (Semmelweis University, University of Szeged) completing the internship at the clinical practice site.
